

# Yellow Rose Chapter EGA Two 2-day Workshops with Vima deMarchi Micheli

## **Thursday & Friday March 18 & 19, 2010 Italian Knotted Tassels**

Students will learn to make these very unusual tassels which were once done on antique Italian linens. Today it is rare to find them. Here is your chance to learn to make them yourself. They are truly unique and Vima will show you many contemporary variations on the traditional design.

**Length:** Two-day workshop

**Level:** All

**Supplies (to be provided by student):**

- Perle #5 three skeins,
- Persian wool about 30 yards,
- Felt square to match perle cottons best possible,
- bias tape, single fold, 1/2 inch width
- Tapestry needles 18, 20, and 22

The great basilica of St. Mark's in Venice is the inspiration for this design. Walking by the "portone", main door, of the basilica, Vima was inspired by the graceful lines and eclectic textures. In this class Vima will show the students how these architectural details can be translated on canvas. This design is stitched with perle cotton and floss on 18ct. mono canvas in one color value selected by the student. A variety of surface stitches will be used such as needlelace, Casalguidi band and buillions, as well as pulled thread patterns and counted thread patterns. The finished design measures 5 ½ x 9 ½ inches.

**Length:** Two-day workshop

**Level:** All

**Supplies (to be provided by student):**

- 18 count canvas 8" X 12",
- stretcher bars
- tacks
- Tapestry needles 18, 20, 22
- Perle #5 three skeins (same color as canvas)
- Perle #8 one ball (same color as canvas)
- floss three skeins (same color as canvas)
- a brightly colored basting thread.
